

Ken-Betwa Phase-I, Phase-II, Damanganga-Pinjal, Par-Tapi-Narmada and Mahanadi-Godavari links have been prioritised. The MoA for implementation of Ken-Betwa link project has been sent to party States of M.P. and U.P for concurrence. Both the Chief Ministers have been invited for signing the MoA. The draft MoA for implementation of Damanganga-Pinjal and Par-Tapi-Narmada link along with 4 Intra State links of Maharashtra has been sent to concerned States of Gujarat and Maharashtra for concurrence.</p> <p>Hon'ble Minister(WR,RD&GR) held a meeting with Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh on 13.02.2018 for implementation of the Ken-Betwa Link Project.</p> <p>MoU has been signed amongst Wildlife Institute of India(WII), National Tiger Conservation Authority(NTCA), MoWR,RD&GR, State of Madhya Pradesh and State of Uttar Pradesh for development of Landscape Management Plan(LMP) and Monitoring with reference to Ken-Betwa Link Project in Panna Tiger Reserve, Madhya Pradesh. An advance payment of Rs.6.27 crore has been released to WII for preparation of LMP.</p> <p>Secretary(WR,RD&GR) convened a meeting with officials of Govt of Maharashtra and Gujarat on 20.04.2018 for finalisation of combined MoA for implementation of Damanganga-Pinjal and Par-Tapi-Narmada Link Projects.</p> <p>Secretary(WR,RD&GR) convened a meeting with officials of Govt of MP and UP on 23.04.2018 for finalisation of MoA for implementation of Ken-Betwa Link Project.</p> <p>Hon'ble Minister(WR,RD&GR) held a meeting with Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh on 18.05.2018 for implementation of Ken-Betwa Link Project. Hon'ble Minister(WR,RD&GR) reviewed the status of ILR projects on 31.05.2018. Preparation of DPR of Godavari(Akinepalli)-Cauvery(Grand Anicut) link project has been taken up by NWDA. Secretary(WR,RD&GR) discussed the issue of compensatory afforestation for 6017 ha for Ken-Betwa link project with Director General, Forests&Special Secretary, MoEF&CC on 25.05.2018. NWDA requested PCCF(WL) of Govt of UP for notification regarding bringing Ranipur Wildlife Sanctuary of UP under Project Tiger. Similarly, NWDA requested PCCF(WL) of Govt of MP for notification regarding bringing Nauradehi and Rani Durgawati Wildlife Sanctuaries of MP under Project Tiger.</p>
