Based on the concurrence of the concerned States, Detailed Project Reports of Ken-Betwa link project Phase-I & Phase-II, Damanganga-Pinjal link and Par-Tapi-Narmada link have been completed. The techno-economic clearance has been accorded to the Ken-Betwa link project phase-I subject to various statutory clearances. All the statutory clearances viz., Environmental, Tribal, Forest land diversion, investment, except clearance from Central Empowered Committee(CEC) of Hon'ble Supreme Court, have been obtained. The techno-economic clearance to the Damanganga-Pinjal link project has also been accorded subject to statutory clearances. DPR of Par-Tapi-Narmada link project is under technical appraisal in CWC. Hon'ble Minister (MoWR, RD & GR) convened a meeting of Chief Ministers of UP, MP, Gujarat and Maharashtra on 25.09.2017. The Chief Ministers of both MP and UP States agreed for implementation of the Ken-Betwa link project. Similarly, the Chief Ministers of both Maharashtra and Gujarat States agreed for implementation of the Damanganga-Pinjal link and Par- |

Tapi-Narmada link projects. The Principal Secretary (Irrigation & WR), Govt of UP has sent their views on the draft MoU, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh has instructed his officers to prepare MoU in consultation with their UP counterparts for implementation of Phase-I&II projects of Ken-Betwa Link Project vide letter dated 11.10.2017. Draft MoU for implementation of Ken-Betwa Link Project is under finalization.

An agreement between NWDA and NHPC was signed on 21.11.2017 for preparation of tender document (EPC MODE) on turnkey basis for Ken-Betwa Link Project Phase-I.

A meeting was also held by the Hon'ble Minister (WR, RD & GR) with Senior Officers of MoWR, RD & GR, CWC, NWDA, Govt. of UP, MP, Gujarat and Maharashtra on 16.01.18 wherein status of Ken-Betwa link project, Par-Tapi-Narmada and Damanganga-Pinjal link projects was reviewed.

Hon'ble Minister (WR, RD & GR) convened a meeting with Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh on 13.02.2018 for implementation of Ken-Betwa Link Project. MOU signed by WII, NTCA, MoWR, RD & GR, State of UP and MP for development of Landscape Management Plan and Monitoring with reference to Ken-Betwa link project in Panna Tiger Reserve, MP on 21.03.2018. An amount of Rs.6.27 crore has been released to Director, WII, Dehradun on 31.3.2018 for taking up LMP work.

Modified draft of combined MoU has been sent to Govt of Maharashtra and Gujarat by NWDA for Par-Tapi-Narmada and Damanganga-Pinjal link projects.
