

The functions of Chief Vigilance Officer, NWDA

- To conduct regular and surprise inspections in the sensitive units/spots.
- To review and to streamline procedures which appear to afford scope for corruption or misconduct and for initiating other measures for the prevention, detection and punishment of corruption and other malpractices in the NWDA offices.
- To take action on complaints received from Public / staff members of the NWDA.
- To assist Disciplinary and Appellate Authorities of NWDA in processing disciplinary and vigilance cases.
- Submission of various vigilance returns viz. monthly, quarterly and annually to the Ministry of Water Resources and Central Vigilance Commission, New Delhi.
- Maintenance of Annual Property Returns of NWDA officers.
- To spread greater awareness of dangers of corruption and its evil consequences by organizing Vigilance Awareness Week etc.
- To conduct training/workshop on Vigilance Administration in the field offices of NWDA.
